- 5. to NOT cancel an indebtedness or liability of: to forgive the interest owed on a loan.
- 6. to NOT pardon an offense or an offender

#### Matthew 5:24

Leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.

#### Matthew 5:44-45

But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous.

#### Mark 11:25

And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins.

#### Luke 6:35-38;42

But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you." ... How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me take the speck out of your eye,' when you yourself fail to see the plank in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

Now take some time to think about all of those things you've never let go of in your past that you haven't forgiven for (this includes others and yourself).

Write down what those transgressions are who you hurt, who hurt you.

Write down how you feel about as a result of these unresolved feelings over these things. Be <u>very</u> honest with yourself. Express how you feel and let the emotions flow – release them!

Decide to forgive yourself and others. Forgiveness is not a feeling but a decision of the will and one of the greatest Gifts from God.

Take your list to God and acknowledge your forgiveness to Him. "Lord, I come to You today and give up my unforgiveness.

I forgive myself for \_\_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_\_. At this moment, I choose not to hold these offenses, but put them into Your Hands. God, heal my emotional wounds and help me to be able to move forward without regrets and help me to let go of the past and start fresh. God give me the ability to uplift and comfort to someone else with the same comfort you have given me. I release my past unforgiveness \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ into Your Hands."

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### How Do We Forgive

**Decide** – You will never forgive if you wait until you feel like it. Choose to obey God and steadfastly resist the devil in his attempts to poison you with bitter thoughts. Make a quality decision to forgive, and God will heal your wounded emotions in due time (see Matthew 6:12,14).

2. Depend – Allow who we are in HIM give us the strength and stamina to fogive. We can do all things through HIM.

3. **Obey** – Follow the ordinances and the example set before us by Christ. If we focus on our end goal, we will not allow a distraction such as unforgiveness to hinder us.

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.
